Dear Friends,

I am honored to share our 2019 Annual Report. As you will read, 2019 saw some of the strongest legal work our team has undertaken, with major wins protecting the iconic landscapes and native species that make the West so beautiful and unique.



You will also read about a strong organization. Our staff is larger and more effective than ever, and includes a growing cohort of young, smart attorneys who provide great promise for the future of conservation law. Our board of directors is eleven members strong, and fortifies our work with broad expertise and backgrounds. With a steady win rate of 85% over 17 years and a long list of client-partners and donors, it's clear that we are all in this for the long haul.

We closed out the year in a solid financial position, with funding from individual donors at an all-time high. Our broad community of supporters — each and every one of you — believes in our ability to fight, and win, for the West. I am heartened that so many who have supported our work from the beginning continue to stand with us. And I am grateful that we attracted so many new donors and partners in 2019.

As we head into 2020, we are looking to the future of *Advocates for the West*. We are in the final stages of adopting a new 5-year strategic plan. The process has given us a chance to reflect on where we were at the start of our last 5-year plan. We had a staff of seven and a budget of \$800,000. We had goals to hire two new attorneys and build a budget of \$1 million. Now, with a staff of twelve and a 2020 budget of \$1.68 million, we have far exceeded our own expectations. I look forward to seeing what the next 5 years has in store.

One thing is certain — demand for our legal expertise is on the rise. In the face of policy rollbacks and government abdication of well-established science, we are here to provide dedicated and strategic legal counsel, free of charge, to our large and growing list of client-partners and concerned citizens.

We welcome each new opportunity to fight for our environment. And we take heart in having you by our side as we continue to win for the West's treasured public lands, waterways and wildlife. Thank you!

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 PROTECTING FISH AND WILDLIFE

Sage-Grouse

We challenged Trump BLM’s efforts to weaken sage-grouse protections on BLM lands and **won a strong ruling that protects 51 million acres of sage-grouse habitat in 7 states** from expanded oil and gas leasing, mining, and other destructive activities in sensitive habitat.

We also are seeking to have dozens of BLM oil and gas leases in sage-grouse habitat thrown out based on **BLM’s effort to exclude the public and avoid environmental reviews** under the Trump “energy dominance” agenda for public lands.

Bighorn Sheep

In two new lawsuits seeking to protect bighorn sheep from fatal diseases spread by domestic sheep grazing on public lands, we are **challenging the USDA Sheep Experiment Station’s reauthorization of domestic sheep grazing** in and around Idaho’s Centennial Mountains, and the Forest Service’s decision to graze **domestic sheep within bighorn sheep habitat** on Colorado’s Wishbone allotment.

Wolves

We won a strong opinion from the 9th Circuit **upholding our clients’ “standing” to challenge rogue agency Wildlife Services** for inadequate analysis of its wolf killing activities in Idaho, including aerial gunning of wolves supposedly to help boost elk and deer populations.

Wild Salmon & Steelhead

In a major victory, the 9th Circuit appeal court affirmed that **EPA must act under the Clean Water Act to protect salmon and steelhead** from dangerously high river temperatures in the Columbia and lower Snake Rivers, caused by dams and climate change.

We are in federal court **challenging the Army Corps’ ESA violations in failing to improve fish passage** and provide adequate flows for endangered salmon and steelhead at several old Corps’ dams in Oregon’s Upper Willamette River watershed.

We also won an Idaho federal court decision **faulting the Forest Service’s 20-year delay in improving two dozen outmoded irrigation diversions** in the Sawtooth Valley of central Idaho, which block streams and harm Idaho’s imperiled salmon, steelhead and bull trout.

Oregon Spotted Frog

In another victory for Oregon spotted frogs and their sensitive fen habitats on Oregon’s Fremont-Winema National Forest, our legal actions **forced the Forest Service to reduce grazing on the large Chemult pasture by over 90%** in summer 2019.

 DEFENDING SPECIAL PLACES

Bears Ears National Monument, UT

Our lawsuit challenging BLM’s sale of **oil and gas leases just outside the Bears Ears National Monument**, one of the richest archaeological areas on public lands, has resulted in interim suspension of the leases, preventing oil and gas drilling in sites considered sacred to many Native American peoples.

Duck Creek, UT

We are challenging the Interior Board of Land Appeals arbitrary rejection of science proven by our clients after extensive hearing, showing **severe grazing degradation of sage-grouse and other wildlife habitat** on the Duck Creek allotment in northern Utah.

Little Colorado Basin, AZ

We **filed suit challenging BLM’s oil and gas lease sale** in the Little Colorado River basin without any new environmental analysis, under Trump administration policy that requires the BLM to offer industry-nominated parcels for lease.

Desert Conservation Lands, CA

We are **challenging a BLM proposal to allow gold mine exploration in critical Joshua Tree woodlands**, which contains habitat for imperiled native plants and areas of critical environmental concern.

Point Reyes National Seashore, CA

Under our prior court-approved settlement, the US Park Service just released a draft EIS for a **new general management plan for the Point Reyes National Seashore**, where industrial dairies and ranching have degraded native habitats and triggered killing of native Tule elk.

Centennial Mountains, ID

We **won a ruling that the Forest Service acted “arbitrarily and capriciously” in approving a 5-year gold mining exploration project** in the Caribou-Targhee National Forest. The court determined that the agency failed to adequately consider the impacts of Otis Gold’s Kilgore project on water quality and the Yellowstone cutthroat trout.

Winter Habitat, ID

We intervened in a snowmobile industry lawsuit challenging a recent winter travel plan on the Sawtooth National Forest, **to defend the plan’s closure of snow machine use in winter habitat areas** important to protect imperiled lynx, wolverines, and other species.

 SAFEGUARDING WATER

Clean Water Act (CWA) Violations, OR

Our settlement with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) over ongoing CWA violations **requires ODFW fish hatcheries across the state to improve their pollution clean-up measures**.

East Fork of the South Fork Salmon River, ID

Partnering with the Nez Perce Tribe, we **won a victory against Midas Gold** when the court denied the Canadian mining company’s motion to stay or dismiss our CWA case over the pollution from the Stibnite Mine site.

Hells Canyon, OR

Also with the Nez Perce Tribe, we are challenging Oregon’s CWA certification of a federal license renewal for Idaho Power’s Hells Canyon dams. Located within the Tribe’s aboriginal homeland, the dams block fish passage and degrade water quality by generating toxic methylmercury that bioaccumulates in the Snake River.

Middle Fork Boise River, ID

We **won a ruling holding Atlanta Gold in contempt of court and the CWA** for not cleaning up ongoing pollution into Montezuma Creek, a tributary of the Middle Fork Boise River in Idaho. Our CWA litigation since 2011 has defeated Atlanta Gold’s effort to develop a new cyanide heap leach gold mine at the site.

South Fork Clearwater River, ID

This CWA suit **targets Shannon Poe, head of the “American Mining Rights Association” which denies federal authority to regulate suction dredge mining**. In July, the federal court denied Poe’s motion to dismiss our lawsuit.

Devil’s Corral Spring, ID

We **successfully blocked a developer’s attempt to use an old water right application** to avoid public involvement in a proposal to divert the entire flow of Devil’s Corral Spring, a pristine stream above Shoshone Falls in the Snake River.

 PROMOTING RESILIENT COMMUNITIES

Boise Urban Warfare Training

We are **challenging the Air Force’s failure to involve the public and disclose noise and other impacts of its plans to conduct “urban warfare training”** in Boise and other cities in southern Idaho, from the Mountain Home AFB. We represent a group of concerned local residents who want to ensure the Air Force is transparent and candid about its plans, before approving them.

NEW AND INNOVATIVE PROGRAM WORK

Soon after President Trump was elected, *Advocates for the West* began working with the Conservation Lands Foundation (CLF) on an exciting, and critical, new program. We are partnering with CLF to produce a series of advocacy and education trainings and webinars designed to arm their 70+ “Friends” groups with legal knowledge and skills. These groups are primarily grassroots organizations throughout the West that specialize in environmental advocacy but, after Trump was elected, found themselves in need of legal expertise in order to continue their work protecting the public lands, water and wildlife we all love. To date, *Advocates for the West* has presented over 20 courses to hundreds of staff, volunteers and board members, on topics covering our bedrock environmental laws and how to engage in agency decision-making.

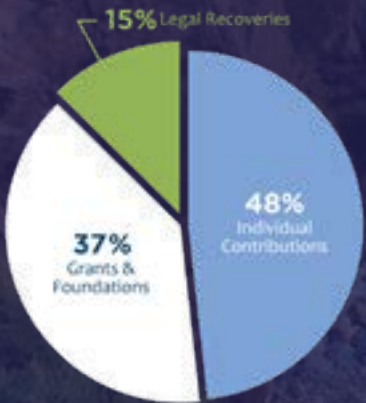

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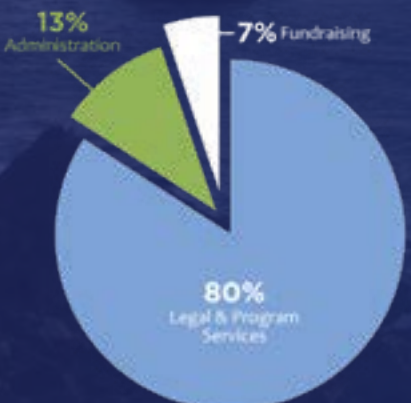
